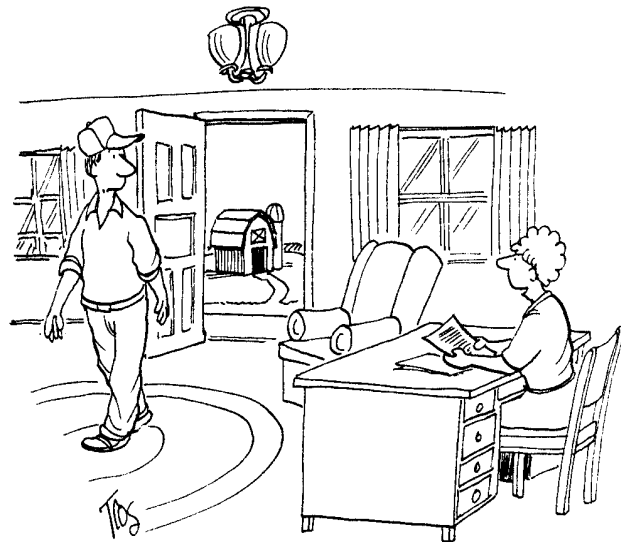

The garden soil needs to be continually moist.

### April Fools' Day

April Fools' Day is celebrated on April 1<sup>st</sup> every year in different countries around the world. Sometimes this is referred to as *All Fools' Day*. It is not a national holiday, but is widely known as a day of practical jokes and pranks.

April Fools' Day seemed to have begun in France in 1564. April 1 used to be New Year's Day, but New Years was changed to January 1 that year. People who insisted on celebrating the old New Year became known as April fools and it became common to play jokes on them.



The traditional day for filing tax returns is April 15<sup>th</sup>.

However, April 15, 2012, falls on a Sunday. And, April 16, 2012 is Emancipation Day in the District of Columbia, so the due day for Federal tax filing is April 17, 2012.

Emancipation Day is a holiday in Washington D.C. to mark the anniversary of the signing of the Compensated Emancipation, which president Abraham Lincoln signed on April 16, 1862.

Please note, state filing deadlines are different. Check your own state for the filing deadline.
